

Fund Policy: The Gardens At Calvary Memorial Fund

The Gardens At Calvary, in exercise of its mission and purpose, has established a memorial fund to provide a convenient method for donors to honor others through their support of various projects designed to supplement and further enrich the environment and services experienced by Gardens residents.

The administration of the fund, including all disbursements, is subject to the control and discretion of the organization's Director. The Director may consider recommendations from any donors for the use of the proceeds of the fund, but in no event is the Director bound to honor any specific recommendations. Donors will not be permitted to recover a donation on the grounds that the Director failed to honor the donor's recommendation.

Because this is expected to be an ongoing fund that will support a series of projects over time, it is likely there may be occasions when donations for a current project may exceed that project's needs, in which case they may be carried over to the next project. Although at various times specific donations projects may be referred to by each project's own goal description, all such projects are subsets of this fund and its policy.

If in the future the Director determines that this fund should be closed, any remaining amount in the fund may be transferred to the general operating budget of The Gardens At Calvary.
